Highlights

- Overall trade has been affected by China, as the annualized dollar value of US agricultural exports has declined 1.1% since pre-trade-war 2017, while the volume of exports has fallen 4.6%
- During the same period, the annualized value of agricultural exports to China has declined 46.5%, while volume has decreased 55%
- On an annualized basis, US exports to China have declined over \$9 billion since 2017. Total US ag
 exports have declined over the same period by just \$1.5 billion, partially offsetting the impacts of the tariff
 war
- There is significant weakness in the year-over-year export values of oilseed product, dairy product, and tobacco product exports, categories in which China has imported 10.5%, 54.8%, and 100%, respectively, less than last year
- · Farm incomes continue to be affected by the trade war, low prices, and Midwest flooding, and other issues

Trade War Background

Trade disputes with international trade partners have been a significant cause for market volatility since the start of 2018, a time in which the US announced tariffs on all imported washing machines and solar panels and later on steel, aluminum, and other imports. Partner nations have countered US actions by imposing new and steeper tariffs of their own. While progress has been made on some fronts, the media has homed in on the evolving and very unpredictable relationship with China and the plight of the American farmer as a result of China's retaliatory tariffs on US agricultural products.

China, once a top export destination of US agricultural products, has drastically cut its imports from the US and has even taken measures to <a href="https://halt.us.org/halt

China was importing near or more than \$20 billion of agricultural goods from the US through 2017 and accounted for roughly 14-16% of all US ag exports. When the US began implementing tariffs in 2018, China reduced its US ag imports by more than 50% in value, ending 2018 at \$9.1 billion (a 60%+ decline in volume as well). In the year-to-date period through May, China has reduced its US ag expenditures by another 30.5%. Surprisingly, despite the cutback in trade from China, the dollar value of US ag exports increased in 2018, thanks to increases in exports to other countries, with notable increases to South Korea, Egypt, Vietnam, Argentina, and others. Through the first five months of 2019, total ag exports from the US are down \$2.9 billion, or 4.9%, of which 78% of the decline is accounted for in declines from China and Hong Kong.

On the broader agricultural spectrum, though trade is down considerably year to date, the US has been able to partially fill China's gap in exports by increasing exports to other partners. And while trade is down, it is noteworthy that overall export value did increase in 2018, when there was seemingly a greater concern of trade issues with other key trade nations, such as NAFTA partners (now USMCA) Canada and Mexico, and that the year-to-date decline currently pales in comparison to the decline experienced in 2015, when overall agricultural export value declined 11.3% to \$133.1 billion on the back of a strong US Dollar.

China Fiercely Determined to Battle Trade War

In nearly every sub-sector of agriculture, trade to China has declined year to date. While this has affected certain producers, others have seen a marginal impact due to China's trade differential, with some seeing minor overall trade differences and some even seeing increases in overall trade spend. For example, the year-to-date value of horticultural products, dairy products, and planting seeds exports are up 2.1%, 2.5%, and 0.8%, respectively, despite that China has imported 13.8%, 33.7%, and 21.7%, respectively, less in value of those products than the first five months of 2018. Factors beyond trade relations continue to affect demand of US agricultural products, including currency strength relative to the US Dollar; diseases, such as African swine fever; regional weather; geopolitical implications; and other factors.

It is important to note China's buying patterns within individual commodities to fully understand the scope and magnitude of the country's importance to American agriculture. On the next page, we review general trends among the leading US agricultural exports.



Oilseeds & Products – Once the largest category of American agriculture and significantly comprised of soybeans and soybean products, this aggregate group has suffered the most in the trade war, with annualized 2019 export values falling over 17% from pre-trade-war 2017 levels. In 2018, the US exported to China roughly a quarter of what it had in 2017, with exports to the country falling over \$9 billion. Year to date, overall oilseed product exports are down 10% to \$10.6 billion, while exports to China are down 18.1% to \$2.4 billion. Interestingly, China remains the largest purchaser of US oilseed products despite that China made a significant shift to Brazilian products in 2018. Historically, China accounted for just under half of US oilseed exports but accounted for just 11.7% in 2018. The decline in trade to China is partially offset by increases of exports to countries such as Argentina, South Korea, Ecuador, the United Kingdom, Portugal, and others.

Grains & Feeds – Corn; wheat; and feed, ingredients, & fodder typically make up approximately 75% of the grains & feeds category. This category actually saw an increase in export value in 2018 and is up approximately 6.6% in value on an annualized basis from 2017. In 2018, China cut back the value of its grains and feeds imports by 37% and has cut back a shocking 73.2% in the year-to-date period, dragging year-to-date overall export values within the category down 4.7%. Once the number-one export market for grains and feeds, China has slipped to #11 thus far in 2019. Increased exports to Mexico, Nigeria, Indonesia, Canada, and Japan have helped offset declines from China.

Livestock & Meats – Livestock and meat products, largely composed of beef and pork products, have maintained strength in the export market, increasing 3% in value in 2018. Approximately 70% of the 5.3% year-to-date decline in value is attributable to declines from China and Hong Kong; however, it is notable that, despite the value of exports to China declining 17.3% year to date, the volume of livestock and meat exports to China has increased 19.8% in the same period, largely due to an increase of exports of rendered products and, to a lesser extent, increased exports of pork products. Offsetting approximately one-third of the total year-to-date decline are increases in export value to Singapore, Australia, Chile, the Netherlands, and South Korea. China is estimated to have lost somewhere in the range of 150 million to 200 million hogs due to African swine fever, and some analysts estimate that it could take a decade for China's pork supply to rebound. US pork exports should benefit from this event.

Horticultural Products – Horticultural products have become the US' standout agricultural export product with the declines in grain and oilseed products. In the 2014 to 2017 period, the value of horticultural exports has increased every year, dipping slightly in 2018 to return to growth in the year-to-date period of 2019. Strength in this category has been driven by value increases in American hops, floriculture products, essential oils, and other miscellaneous products. While China was never as big of an export market for US horticulture products as it was, for example, for oilseed products, the product category remains an interesting case for ag exports to China, as it was the only category value that increased each year from 2014 to 2018, and it is only down a relatively smaller 6.4% thus far in 2019. While China has significantly reduced its imports of American wine products, hops, and ginseng (on a value basis – China has increased ginseng imports from the US 39% in YTD 2019 on a volume basis), the export value of the USDA's "miscellaneous horticulture products" to China has been a key growth driver for the category from 2014 to the present.

Other – While the previous categories are the leading categories of US ag exports (currently accounting for 80% of total export value), it is important to note trends in other commodity categories. While cotton, linters, and waste is a volatile category in terms of export values, and despite that China is currently on pace to import 40% less product within the category than last year, the total value of exports to China in this category is only slightly down from 2017 on an annualized basis. However, it should be noted that China once received 25% of US exports of the category and now represents 12%. Despite the significant cutback from China, it seems the US has been mostly able to find replacement markets. US dairy exports to China are down 36% on a value basis year to date. While China continues to be a growing export market globally for dry milk products (e.g., non-fat dry milk, whole milk powder, skim milk powder, etc.), as the country remains shaken from the melamine scare of the 2000s, the country has practically stopped importing these products from the US, as the categories are down in excess of 80% on a volume basis in 2019. Of the sub-\$100-million categories, perhaps the most significant item of note is that China, once a considerable export market of US tobacco products, appears to have stopped importing US tobacco in 2019. Lastly, poultry is the lone category that saw an increase in trade value to China in 2019, though the category is relatively immaterial. Interestingly, despite China's 2015 ban on US poultry imports, due to concerns over Avian bird flu, China appears to have begun to import live poultry in December 2018 and each subsequent month of 2019. Through the first five months of 2019, China has imported over five million birds, accounting for \$23 million of the value within the category.

US Farm Income Down; Future Uncertain

It is clear that China has taken drastic measures that have caused a subsequent reduction of imports from the US. Despite that the US has been able to fill some of the void left by China, American farmers are in a tight position in which the trade war is stretching their limits. Earlier this year, the USDA released its March 2019 Farm Income Forecast, which noted that net farm income was expected to increase \$6.3 billion, or 10%, from 2018 levels to \$69.4 billion in 2019. However, a Commerce Department report that was released at the end of April showed that personal income for farmers hit a three-year low in the first quarter. According to the report, the annualized rate of farm personal income fell \$11.8 billion, or nearly 25% - the largest drop since 2016 - from the fourth quarter of 2018. As an illustration of the issues at hand, Kansas' average net farm income increased to \$100,000 in 2018, but the big catch was that 63% of the income was accounted for by crop insurance and government payments, according to the Kansas Farm Management Association. Historic Midwest floods, rain, and soft prices exacerbated trade issues in the first quarter and are ongoing yet.

Nearly every week, there is a new development on the trade front. While ideas and ceasefires have been implemented, the parties to the war have also suddenly backed out of discussions numerous times. The protectionist, beggar-thy-neighbor economies have been dueling for over a year, and while the countries are currently in talks to resume peace discussions, anything is but certain. One thing Americans have to look forward to is an upcoming election, which may force a more substantial move one way or the other.
